How a Podcast is Structured

Types of Podcasts:

- **Talk Podcast**

Informal, spontaneous conversation, interaction between host and guests. *Examples: Tintoria, The Rest is Politics, The Joe Rogan Experience*

How a Podcast is Structured

Types of Podcasts:

- **Documentary Podcast**

In-depth narration, including interviews, research, and original material. Covers True Crime and investigative journalism. *Examples: Veleno, West Cork, Serial*

How a Podcast is Structured

Types of Podcasts:

- **Storytelling Podcast (Narrative/Monologue)**

A narrator leads the story, often emotional and engaging, with careful writing and pacing.

Examples: Non hanno un amico, Cerno Lungo, The Daily

How a Podcast is Structured

Types of Podcasts:

- **Fiction Podcast (Audio Drama)**
Scripted stories acted out by voice actors, with immersive sound design. *Examples: Batman Unburied, The Magnus Archives, Welcome to Night Vale*

How a Podcast is Structured

Types of Podcasts:

- **Educational/Didactic Podcast**

Structured explanations to aid learning and comprehension; clear and direct pace. *Examples: Barbero Podcast, Coffee Break Languages, Hardcore History*

How a Podcast is Structured

Types of Podcasts:

- **Anthology Podcast**
Self-contained episodes connected by a common theme. Examples: Demoni Urbani, Death in Ice Valley, Radiolab
