Title: IMO STCW Basic Safety Training - 1

Location: Tecno Italia Safety and Survival Training, Anzio (RM)

Name of the speakers: Tecno Italia Safety and Survival Training staff

Brief description of the course: The course is essential to ensure that seafarers are prepared to handle emergency situations and contribute to the safety of the ship and crew. The course is divided into several sections, including Personal Safety and Liability, Fire Prevention and Fighting, Rescue and aid, Safety at Sea.

Learning objectives: STCW stands for "Standard of Training, Certification, and Watchkeeping" and the course is designed to provide the fundamental skills needed for the maritime career to ensure safety and survival on board. Combining theory and practice, this program provides knowledge of safety at sea, survival, and shipboard behavior. Simulation practice tests for challenging and collaborative learning.

Syllabus:

2. Personal Survival Techniques Training Course, 20 h
